

fly away with me *card*

you'll need

Papers

- Card stock: white; ivory.
- Miss Elizabeth's patterned (Dollar Tree).
- Hera metallic ivory (The Paper Cut).

Embellishments

- Bliss Adhesive Pearls (KaiserCraft).
- Sheer blue ribbon.

Tools & Supplies

- Bird and Vine stamp set (Flourishes).
- Ink pads: Adirondack® Lights Aqua (Ranger®); VersaFine® Onyx Black (Tsukineko®).
- Stardust Gelly Roll Pen (Sakura).
- Foam adhesive dots.

what to do

1 Make white side-fold card base. Cut floral paper piece to same size as card front and adhere. 2 Cut smaller panel from blue patterned paper; stamp with Aqua vines image. Dot flower buds with Stardust pen. Mat stamped piece on metallic paper; adhere pearls to corners. Adhere panel to card. 3 Stamp black bird on white card stock and black sentiment on ivory; cut out bird and trim sentiment to 1"x2 1/8". Mat sentiment on metallic ivory card stock. 4 Cut 7" ribbon length and knot at center. Adhere knot to card. Use adhesive dots to adhere bird and sentiment to card over ribbon, giving the appearance that bird is flying away with the sentiment.
