card & button jar gift

Vintage sewing machine stamp + trendy trims + contemporary colors = a perfect girlfriend "thank you" that's almost too cute to give away!

you'll need

Surface & Papers

- Cracker jar, 16 oz. (Anchor Hocking).
- Card stock: Light Citron Felt, Tivoli Green, Pacific Blue (The Paper Cut); Basic Black, Whisper White (Stampin' Up!®).

Embellishments

- Ribbon: black satin; ruler print (The Paper Studio); black/white gingham (American Crafts).
- Buttons: Boardwalk Blue, Seaside, Vanilla (Lasting Impressions); Pastel Bag O' Buttons (The Paper Studio); 5th Avenue Epoxy (Making Memories).
- Essentials 4 Paper Flowers (Prima Marketing Inc.).

Tools & Supplies

- Many Happy Returns stamp set (Gina K. Designs).
- VersaFine™ Onyx Black ink pad (Tsukineko).
- Prismacolor colored pencils (Sanford®): White; Burnt Umber.
- Pens: Zig® Painty silver fine-tip (EK Success); Inkssentials™ White Opaque Pen (Ranger®).
- Marvy® craft punches (Uchida); Mega Oval; Giga Scalloped Oval.
- Circle cutter.
- Nestabilities™ Scalloped Circle Dies (Spellbinders) and compatible die-cutting system.
- Computer and printer with Smarty Pants BTN or other decorative font.
- Sewing needle with black thread.
- Adhesives: foam mounting tape; Zots® Mini Glue Dots (Therm O Web); double-stick tape.

what to do

Card

1 Make white top-fold card base. Cut 2"x5¼" blue card stock strip and 2¼"x5¼" dark lime strip. Wrap bottom edge of blue strip with ruler ribbon, aligning edges and adhering ends to back. Adhere strips to card front as shown. 2 Stamp sewing machine on light lime card stock; color with pencils. Accent metal parts of sewing machine with silver pen. Punch image into large

oval. 3 Punch scalloped oval from black card stock; dot scallops with white gel pen. Adhere oval layers together with foam tape; adhere to card with foam tape. 4 Adhere three small buttons to card front. Stamp sentiment below buttons and ribbon.

Jar

1 Use computer to print following sentiments on blue card stock, leaving space around each: "Got Buttons?"; "Have a button? Give a button. Need a button. Take a button."



project sizes: card, 4¼"x5¾"; jar, 16 oz.



button? Take a button."

2 Using circle cutter, cut "Got Buttons?" into 2½"-diameter circle. Die cut slightly larger scalloped circle from black card stock; dot scallops with white gel pen. Use circle cutter to cut 2¼" diameter circle from light lime circle. Adhere circles together and to lid. 3 Trim remaining sentiment to 1⅞"x2⅜" and mat on light lime card stock. Adhere black ribbon tab to back of tag. Adhere green button to ribbon tab using mini glue dot; sew through button holes with black thread. Adhere panel to jar front. 4 Adhere ruler ribbon around rim of lid using double-stick tape. Tie gingham ribbon through epoxy button and adhere to blue flower center; adhere to lid rim. Fill jar with buttons and replace lid.
