DIRECTIONS

- 1** Stamp Cobalt images onto tag as shown. Stipple Wild Plum, Stonewashed, and Stream inks over tag. Use nibs to color bird Sunshine Yellow and Terra Cotta.
- 2** Highlight bird's eye with white pen and Enamel Accents; let dry.
- 3** Stamp hat and "Machine" onto second tag using Cobalt ink. Detail cut image and word, saving remainder of second tag for a future project. Stipple word Sunshine Yellow; ink edges Cobalt.
- 4** Adhere word with Glossy Accents and hat with foam tape. Tie ribbon through hole in tag.
