you'll need

Papers

- Card stock (Bazzill Basics Paper): White; Deep Blue Textured; Light Gray; Brown Textured.
- Patterned (Basic Grey, Miss Elizabeth's, Provo Craft & We R Memory Keepers): Snowy Sky; Green Distressed; Light Brown Distressed; Dark Brown.

Embellishments

- White felt.
- Stickers™ (Ranger®).
- Rhinestones (Me and My Big Ideas): Red; Blue.

Tools & Supplies

- Stamp (Studio G): Jingle All The Way.
- Ink pads: Navy Blue; Light Blue.
- Sizzix™ Machine and Tree Die (Ellison).
- Cricut™ and Christmas Cheer cartridge (Provo Craft®).
- All Night Media® Pop Dots™ (Plaid®).
- Brown chalk.
- Markers: Red; Fine-tip Black.

what to do

1 Cut white card stock to 6"x12"; score and fold in half. Cut deep blue card stock to 5 $\frac{5}{8}$ " square; adhere to card. 2 Cut snowy paper to 5 $\frac{5}{8}$ " square. Ink edges with light blue ink; adhere to card. 3 Cut white felt to 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ "x5 $\frac{3}{8}$ ". Trim top edge to make snowbank; adhere to card. 4 Use Sizzix™ Machine to cut pine trees from green distressed paper and brown card stock. Adhere to card. Add Stickers™ to trees. 5 Use Cricut™ to cut reindeer from light brown and dark brown paper and light gray card stock. Trim pieces; add details with black marker. Shade body with chalk; add red rhinestone nose. Adhere to card with Pop Dots™. 6 Use navy ink to stamp sentiment on snow paper. Color open letters with red marker; adhere blue rhinestone.
