

rejoice crackle *card*



project size: 6"x6"

you'll need

Papers

- Card stock (Bazzill): Red.
- Patterned (Basic Grey): Figgy Pudding.

Embellishments

- Ribbon (Offray).
- Stickers™ (Ranger®).
- Beads (Sulyn Industries).
- Embroidery thread (DMC®) and needle.
- Chipboard tag (EK Success).
- Rub-on transfer (Making Memories®).

Tools & Supplies

- Colorbox Fluid Chalk (Clearsnap): Brown.

- Crackle Medium (Plaid®).
- Acrylic paints (Making Memories®): Brown; Cream.
- Sewing machine and thread.

what to do

- 1 Cut Red card stock to 6"x12"; score and fold in half. Lightly apply cream paint to edges; let dry.
- 2 Cut green paper to 4" square. Ink and machine stitch edges.
- 3 Trim flower from patterned paper; adhere to green square. Hand sew

beads to flower center; adhere layer to card. 4 Paint chipboard tag in layers, allowing to dry between coats. First brown, then crackle medium, then white. Apply rub-on sentiment. Tie ribbon through tag holes. Adhere to card front. 5 Apply Stickers™ to flower; let dry.
