

3-D snowglobe ornament

Turn the lid of a plain papier-mâché box into a fabulous 3-D ornament!

you'll need

Surfaces & Embellishments

- Round papier-mâché box lid, 3¾" (Hobby Lobby).
- Good Tidings patterned (KI Memories): Tree Skirt, Wonderland.
- Mistletoe Circle Journaling stickers (Making Memories®).
- Bird clip (Two's Company).
- Silver star.
- Red berry pick.
- Red and white striped ribbon.
- Transparency film (3M).
- Silver thread.

Tools & Supplies

- FolkArt® Wicker White acrylic paint (Plaid®).
- Ultra Fine Prisma Glitter (Hero Arts®).
- Mod Podge® Gloss (Plaid®).
- Gem-Tac permanent adhesive (Beacon).
- Foam brush.
- Needle.
- Circle cutter.

what to do

1 Paint all surfaces of box lid; let dry. 2 Adhere "Merry Christmas" journaling sticker inside lid. 3 Using cutter, cut 3½" circle from Tree Skirt paper; adhere to back of lid with Mod Podge®. Cut strip of Wonderland paper; adhere to outside lid edge with Mod Podge®. Let dry. 4 Apply coat of Mod Podge® to entire lid. Sprinkle with glitter; let dry. 5 Poke two holes in lid edge with needle for hanging. Tie ribbon in bow. Thread needle, pushing needle through holes and ribbon bow. Knot ends to complete loop. 6 Arrange and adhere star, berries and bird inside lid. Sprinkle glitter "snow" in lid. 7 Using cutter, cut 3¾" circle from transparency. Apply adhesive around outside lip of box lid; adhere transparency. Apply adhesive to edge of transparency; sprinkle with glitter. Let dry.
