

playful pom-pom cupcake ornaments



project size: 5" tall

you'll need

Surface & Embellishments

- STYROFOAM™ Brand foam shapes (Dow): ball, 3"; cone, 6".
- Pom-poms, ½":
 - For swirled cupcake: white, approximately 60; pink, approximately 25.
 - For single-color cupcake: approximately 85.
- Red pom-pom, ¾".
- Green felt.
- Satin ribbon, 8" length.
- Pastel scrapbook paper.

Tools & Supplies

- Yes! Paste™ (Gane).
- Hot glue gun.
- Serrated steak knife.
- Straight pins (optional).

what to do

- 1 Using steak knife, cut off top of foam cone 2" from wide end. Cut foam ball in half. Hot glue half dome to widest base of cut cone.
- 2 Cover base of cupcake with paper for "liner". Trace base of cupcake onto same paper to create the bottom of the liner. Cut out.
- 3 Apply a thin coat of Yes! Paste™ to sides of cupcake base. Smooth paper liner around cupcake. Use straight pins to hold in place while drying, if desired. Spread paste on bottom of cupcake base; smooth on bottom circle. Trim when dry, if necessary.
- 4 Using Yes! Paste™, adhere smaller pom-poms to cupcake top, holding in place with straight pins if desired. If making pink pom-pom swirls, adhere pink pom-poms first.
- 5 When dry, glue ribbon loop to cupcake top for hanger.
- 6 Adhere red pom-pom "cherry" on top. Cut little green leaves from felt, adhering to either side of cherry.
