

vintage yo-yo *ornament*



project size: 3"

you'll need

Surface & Embellishments

- STYROFOAM™ Brand foam ball, 4" (Dow).
- Muslin, 1/8 yard.
- Scrap fabrics in varying shades of cream.
- White ball head pins.
- Cream grosgrain ribbon, 18".

Tools & Supplies

- Quick Yo-Yo Maker, large (Clover).
- Fabric glue.
- Needle with cream button thread.
- Scissors.

what to do

- 1 Tear muslin into 1/2" strips. Wrap ball completely with strips, securing ends with fabric glue.
- 2 Following manufacturer's instructions, use yo-yo maker to create yo-yos from fabric scraps. Make enough to completely cover foam ball.*
- 3 Attach yo-yos to foam ball with ball head pins. Yo-yos can overlap slightly.
- 4 Create an 8" ribbon loop and bow. Attach to top of foam ball with pin and fabric glue.

* If not using yo-yo maker, cut 4" circles of fabric scraps. Fold over a 1/4" seam; press with an iron. Gather edges with a running stitch; knot off to create yo-yo.
