

shining poinsettia ornaments

Shimmering accent inks give plain papier-mâché shapes a dose of holiday glamour.

you'll need

Surface & Embellishments

- Papier-mâché ornaments, two.
- Paper blossoms (Prima): red; green; sheer sparkling white.
- Vintage crystal pendants, two.
- Faux pearls, two.
- Icy Silver Fun Wire™, 22-gauge (Toner).

Tools & Supplies

- Smooch™ Pearlized Accent Ink (Clearsnap): Siren; Green Apple.
- Needlenose pliers.
- Wire cutters.
- Sewing needle or paper piercer.
- Aleene's® Original Tacky Glue® (iLovetoCreate™).

what to do

1 Paint ornaments with ink, letting each area dry before moving on. Apply second coat as needed; let dry. 2 Cut two 5" wire lengths. Use needlenose pliers to bend one end of each wire into a 1"-wide spiral for hanger. Bend straight ends into small hooks as shown; insert through holes in tops of ornaments. 3 Use needle to poke hole at bottom of each ornament. Cut and loop short wire length around top jump ring in crystal pendant and glue wire ends into hole; let dry completely. Glue flowers and pearls to sides.
