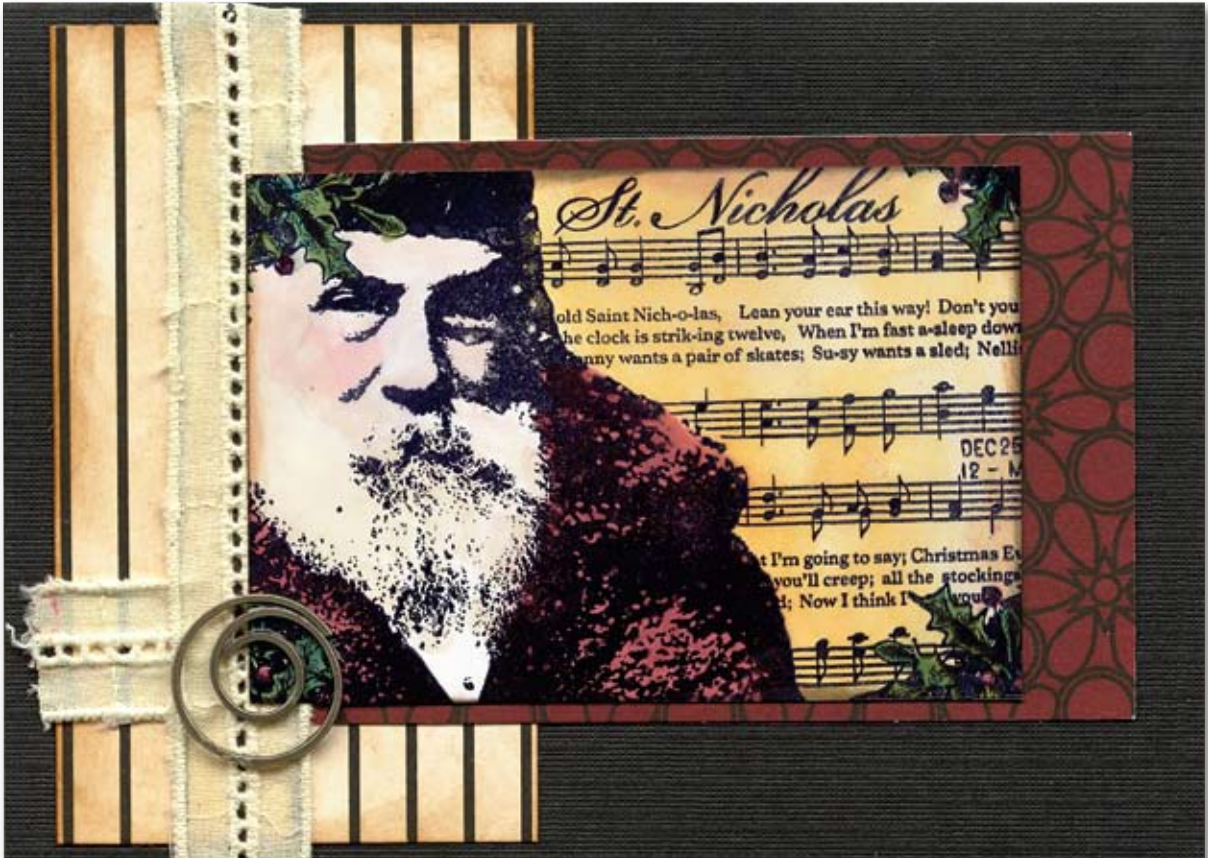


# st. nicholas *card*



project size: 4½"x6¼"

## you'll need

### Papers & Embellishments

- Black textured card stock.
- White Inkssentials™ Gloss Paper\*.
- All Dressed Up Paper Stack (Die Cuts with a View).
- Ivory entredeaux.
- Spiral clip.

### Tools & Supplies

- St. Nicholas stamp set (Oxford Impressions).
- Ink pads\*: Jet Black Archival™; Tim Holtz™ Distress Ink™ in Tattered Rose, Worn Lipstick, Antique Linen, Fired Brick, Pine Needles, Peeled Paint, Aged Mahogany, Spiced Marmalade, Vintage Photo, Black Soot.
- Inkssentials™ Cut-N-Dry™ Nibs.\*
- Inkssentials™ Cut-N-Dry™ Foam Pad.\*
- Inkssentials™ Heat-It craft tool.\*
- Inkssentials™ Glossy Accents™.\*

## what to do

- 1 Create top-fold 4½"x6¼" card base from card stock.
- 2 Cut Gloss Paper to 2¾"x4". Using Jet Black ink, stamp image; heat set. Using Nibs, apply Distress Inks™ to color image as follows: skin – Tattered Rose with Worn Lipstick highlights; beard – Antique Linen; Santa suit – Fired Brick; holly – Pine Needles, Peeled Paint, Aged Mahogany; music – Antique Linen, Spiced Marmalade. With foam pad, ink edges with Vintage Photo and Black Soot.
- 3 Cut striped paper to 2½"x4¼"; ink edges with Spiced Marmalade. Cut floral paper to 3"x4½". Adhere to card.
- 4 Cut entredeaux to 1" and 4½" lengths. Line 4½" length so black stripe shows through holes; tuck 1" length underneath. Adhere to card.
- 5 Adhere stamped panel to card.
- 6 Adhere clip to card with Glossy Accents™.
